



Successful Community Collaboration

In July, The Arc of Evansville was notified of a decision to end Community-Based Sheltered Work and Facility-Based Sheltered Work funding due to state budget cuts, particularly the Division of Disability and Rehabilitative Services. As a result, a decision was made to close Arc Industries, a packaging, assembly, and distribution facility that offers employment and vocational training for individuals with disabilities.

Local businesses desiring for Arc Industries to remain open began considering ways to assist. We are excited to report that this community collaboration will allow our facility to stay open and provide opportunities for individuals with disabilities to develop work skills and behaviors to obtain and maintain competitive community employment.

We appreciate this partnership and know it will ensure those served and their families have access to services and supports needed for living a meaningful life.





Community Job Link

Community employment increases a person's overall well-being.

Individuals who are seeking community employment receive assistance in preparing a resume, locating job opportunities, and prepping for a job interview. Once a community job is secured, the individual is supported with job coaching and follow-along services. Individuals with disabilities are more successful in their employment when these services are available. The Community Job Link program is currently accepting new clients. Because of BJ, his group was successful and moved onto the next clue. BJ also spent time making complex crafts, including a walking robot, a cannonball launcher, and a pinball machine. He was challenged to achieve, and BJ excelled!
