and conducting his favorite music. Since music is one of Patrick's passions, he receives Music Therapy services from The Arc. A skill his Music Therapy sessions enhance is counting money. For Patrick, this is an essential skill to improve his employment abilities while growing his independence. Music Therapy activities promote wellness, provide unique opportunities for interaction, and offer an outlet to express feelings.


Patrick also receives services from The Arc's Connections For Life program to be as independent as possible. With an Arc staff member's assistance, Patrick takes responsibility for himself by going to the bank, pharmacy, and local restaurants; this service helps Patrick be independent. Also, it offers the opportunity for recreational activities that Patrick enjoys, such as taking walks along the river while watching the barges.

To increase independence, individuals with disabilities must acquire specific life skills such as developing money management skills, understanding what local services and resources are available and using banks, libraries, and public transportation. When individuals with disabilities live independently, they have an increased quality of life and an improved attitude.




