Improving Life Skills

People with disabilities receive assistance with personalized activities that promote daily living skills, recreation and leisure, self-advocacy, and community resource access.

Creating Employment Opportunities

People with disabilities can secure and retain competitive community employment by enhancing their work-related skills and behaviors.



Increasing Community Engagement

People with disabilities can gain many benefits by getting involved in their local community through volunteer work with nonprofit organizations and participating in social, educational, and recreational activities. Arc Industries

of individuals reported satisfaction with work services.

Hourly wages increased by 11.5% resulting in an increase in productivity.

Served: 102 adults



Community Job Link

of individuals remained on the job after 60 days.

Twenty-six individuals obtained new competitive jobs within the community.

Served: 83 adults



Behavior Support Services

of behavior goals were met.

Maximized staff ability to meet people served face-to-face despite COVID-19 pandemic complications.

Served: 104 adults and children



Connections for Life

of individual's health and wellness goals were met.

Individuals continued to increase skills related to independence and self-sufficiency.

Served: 51 adults



Day Services for Adults

95% of individuals served met their independence goals.

Individuals continued to meet health and wellness goals in midst of COVID-19 pandemic.

Served: 97 adults



Residential Services

85% of service hours were utilized despite COVID-19 pandemic.

All individuals served and respective shareholders reported being satisfied with residential services.

Served: 5 adults



Music Therapy

of individuals received services designed to improve vital skills.

Individuals improved communication, motor, social, cognition, and sensory skills.

Served: 21 adults and children



Respite Services

of individuals served were satisfied with their services.

All staff received specific training directed by family members of individuals served.




Impacts
